








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Introduction



CIBI CaixaBank Index for Business Internationalisation (CIBI 2019)¹

- The CIBI 2019 is an index that ranks foreign countries according to their internationalisation potential from the perspective of Spanish companies. The index is developed by analysing the main aspects that determine the decision made by these Spanish companies to expand internationally into a specific country.
- The main aspects that determine internationalisation are grouped into five basic pillars that cover elements such as the degree of accessibility to each country's market or the financial and innovative environment.
- The analysis is carried out for a total of 67 countries, resulting in a *ranking* that reflects their attractiveness to Spanish companies.
- According to the CIBI 2019, Western Europe is the region with the most favourable conditions for the international expansion of Spanish companies. However, other countries outside this region also score highly, such as the US (in third place), Poland and China.

The CIBI is an index that allows foreign countries to be ranked according to the potential they offer for the international expansion of Spanish companies. In order to draw up the CIBI, we first analysed the main aspects that influence the decision to expand internationally into a specific country from the perspective of the Spanish company. Business internationalisation can take many forms, for example, selling products, searching for suppliers, merging with domestic companies or establishing a production plant in a foreign country.

The analysis has been carried out for a total of 67 countries, including both advanced and emerging countries, resulting in a *ranking* that reflects their attractiveness to Spanish companies. It is precisely the point of view of the Spanish company taken by the CIBI

that is one of its most defining features. This "Spanish" perspective gives it a value that is not found in other, more general, indices.

The CIBI groups the key aspects that determine the decision to expand internationally into five pillars (see the table). These pillars assess the strong and weak points of each country from the point of view of Spanish companies. The five pillars are: the degree of accessibility to each country's market; the ease of operating in each market; that market's commercial attractiveness; the financial and innovative environment; and the macroeconomic and institutional stability.

Each pillar is made up of subpillars that capture the main dimensions of the various aspects. Both the CIBI as well as the various pillars that comprise it use a scale from 0 to 100: the closer to 100, the easier it is for Spanish companies to expand into the country in question.

The first pillar, which refers to accessibility to each country's market, is made up of a subpillar that examines how connected Spain and the country analysed are and another subpillar that analyses the quality of the infrastructures in the foreign country under study.

The second pillar, which measures how easy it is to operate in each country, takes into account the characteristics of the administrative and legal framework and how the job market operates. It also considers Spanish investment already present in the country since the existence of other Spanish investors tends to make it easier for new arrivals to operate.

The third pillar, which refers to commercial attractiveness, summarises the aspects that may contribute to determining the success of selling Spanish products in the country under study. Specifically, it measures the size of the target market and household purchasing power, as well as the success enjoyed by products produced by Spanish companies in each country and vice versa.

The fourth pillar assesses both the financial and innovative environment. Therefore, in relation to finance, it reflects the availability of credit and how developed each country's financial sector is. This is an important aspect when assessing the ability to pay of clients and suppliers, for example. Similarly, for a company that is considering opening a production plant or setting up a point of sale in a given country, it is indicative of the financial instruments available for cash management. With regards to innovation, it reflects both the capacity for innovation as well as the economy's level of entrepreneurship. This may turn out to be especially important for those companies with relatively sophisticated products. It also makes it possible to gauge how easy the search for suppliers in the country may be.

The fifth pillar considers each country's macroeconomic and institutional stability. This can be understood as an image of the uncertainty surrounding the assessment of the above-mentioned pillars. It is therefore a highly relevant aspect to ensure that the internationalisation decisions of a country suit its desired risk profile.

Overall results

According to the CIBI 2019, countries in Western Europe once again have the most favourable conditions for Spanish companies to expand abroad (see the regional comparison chart). They have an average CIBI of 72 points, compared to an average of 55 points for all 67 analysed countries. These countries stand out in all five pillars. Indeed, these countries are the closest to Spain and they have a highly developed administrative and legal framework, a well-trained workforce, significant purchasing power and a solid financial, institutional and innovative environment, among many other positive aspects.


Specifically, there are nine countries from Western Europe in the CIBI's Top 10 (see country comparison chart). The ranking is led by France, our main trading partner in goods, member of the European Union and with which we share a land border. The United Kingdom continues to be an important country in the CIBI 2019 (in comparison with the CIBI 2017), taking second place, despite brexit.² In addition to standing out in the majority of aspects previously mentioned when describing the case of Western Europe, the United Kingdom continues to be one of our most significant export destinations: it is in the lead in terms of international tourists that visit us, despite the recent deterioration, and the investment ties with Spain are notable. In this regard, it is important to specify that the CIBI mainly collects facts on the analysed country (the state of its infrastructures, the commercial relations already established with Spain etc.), and less so risks that have not yet materialised. If the exit of the United Kingdom from the European Union is carried out gradually, and considering that many of the aspects that make the country attractive in the eyes of Spanish business owners will not excessively change with its exit, the country will continue to place highly on the CIBI in future.3

Eastern Europe and Central and Western Asia jointly make up the second region into which it is easier for Spanish companies to expand, closely followed by America, both some distance behind Western Europe. Poland, Turkey and the Czech Republic top the list from this region, mainly facilitated by the commercial attractiveness pillar which reflects the positive reception of Spanish goods and services there. Specifically, Poland is in thirteenth place on the CIBI and Turkey in sixteenth, both ahead of major emerging countries such as Mexico, with a strong historic link to Spain. The Czech Republic is not very far behind, in twentieth place, still ahead of the largest of the emerging Latin American countries, Brazil.

As mentioned earlier, the America region is not far from being the second most attractive area in terms of internationalisation. The US leads the ranking, in third place overall. Meanwhile Canada, the second American country on the list, comes in eleventh. For their part, Mexico and Brazil, the two most significant economies in Latin America, are further away from the top positions. This is especially true with regards to Brazil, where economic difficulties, a weaker level of competition and bureaucratic complexity relegate it to twenty-sixth place, just behind Chile.

Southeast Asia and the Pacific make up the fourth region in terms of Spanish ease of internationalisation. A clear disadvantage is how far away the region is from Spanish companies. However, it should be noted that China, the leading emerging power in the region, is placed highly (fourteenth out of a total of 67 countries), facilitated by the financial and innovative environment and commercial attractiveness pillars. In this regard, the existing close commercial relations with the country still outweigh the possible impact resulting from the Asian economy's commercial tensions with the US.


Africa and the Arab States, despite having a lower index as a whole, are notable for their high degree of heterogeneity. In fact, both areas include countries with a relatively high CIBI 2019, such as Morocco with a clearly above-average CIBI 2019, boosted by accessibility and, in particular, commercial attractiveness.



² The CIBI 2019 has entailed certain methodological changes with regards to the CIBI 2017. For this reason, it is better to compare the two years based on the results that appear in the CIBI 2019. The country-based analysis of the CIBI 2019 includes the results of the 2019 index as well as the results of the CIBI 2018 and CIBI 2017 using the new methodology. Details of the new methodology, as well as the changes with regard to the previous one, are specified in the Working Document stated in footnote 1.


















