Spain · Inflation rises in August

Fact

- The CPI recorded a year-on-year change of 1.6% in August (1.5% in July).
- Month-on-month variation was 0.2% (0.1% in August of 2016).

Assessment

- Inflation rose 1 tenth in August to 1.6%, an increase lower than that forecast by CaixaBank Research.
- In the absence of component details, the increase in inflation in August could be explained by the rise in the price of fuel.
- In the coming months, inflation is expected to moderate due to the deceleration of the price of oil, in year-on-year terms. Likewise, core CPI will remain stable, supported by the strength of private consumption.
- Following this data, the risks of inflation forecast for the whole of 2017, of 1.9%, are slightly biased downwards.
